

Diakoniewerk runs several own businesses that also offer integrative work, a training academy for on-going learning as well as three student residences in Vienna.

The development of new social space oriented residential and living concepts is one of the main activities of Diakoniewerk.

The Diakonie Implementation Foundation supports jobseekers on their way to a training place or job. At three locations in Austria (Vienna, Graz and Linz) LIFEtool offers tools in the field of Augmentative and Alternative Communication (AAC) and advises people with disabilities.
